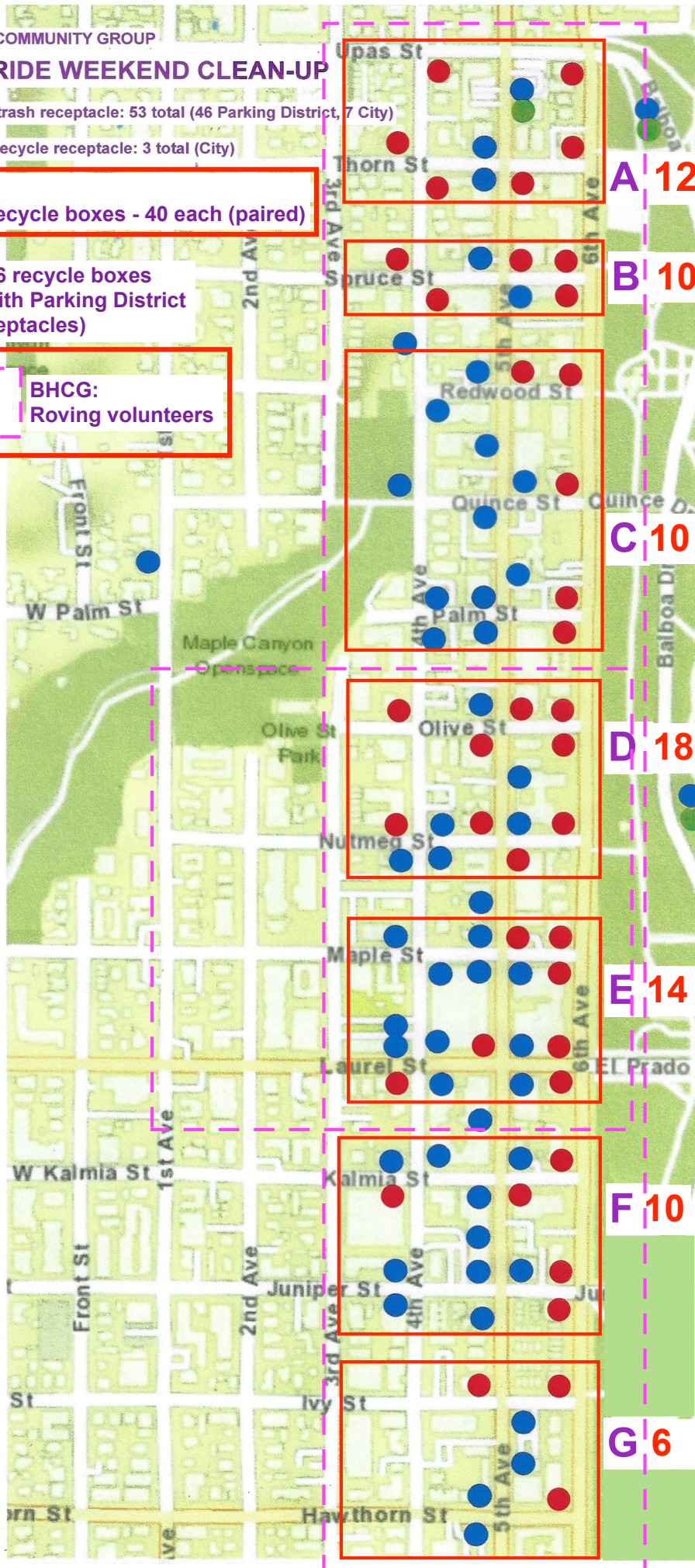

BHCG 2022 PRIDE CLEANUP: July 15 – 18

Box Pickup & Distribution Volunteers:

- Assemble boxes at each location in your designated section on our map (easier than transporting assembled boxes to each location).
- Place 2 or 3 folded bags in the bottom of each box for future use.
- Insert 1 bag in box; secure each side of box with a short piece of **packaging** tape (Scotch tape, painter's tape and masking tape WON'T WORK!)
- **If extremely windy:** Put a couple of rocks in bottom of box (under open bag); place box on leeward side of sign, pole, tree, etc.; tie or tape to sign or pole and hope for the best...

Roving Trash / Recycle Pickup Volunteers:

- Pick up several trash bags at SD Clubhouse Friday afternoon 1-2 PM or provide your own bags. Smaller bags are easier to manage once they start getting full, especially if you're carrying separate trash & recycle bags.
- Provide your own gloves & "grabber".
- Roam BH streets at least twice each day if possible – early AM and again late afternoon are best.
- Place full trash bags in our trash boxes, the City blue receptacles, your own trash bins, or accessible BH business dumpsters.
- Place full recycle bags in our recycle boxes, your own recycle bins, or accessible BH business recycle dumpsters.
- If you see a full trash or recycle box, remove bag & tie closed. Secure new empty bag in box; place full bag inside new bag in the box or take to a nearby bin or dumpster.
