



## SAN DIEGO PRIDE /BANKERS HILL COMMUNITY GROUP 2020 COMMUNITY SERVICE PARTNERSHIP AGREEMENT

Pride Community Service Partnerships are formed with community organizations whose membership desire a larger participatory role in Pride Festival events. A Pride Community Service Partnership calls on the various skills and insights unique to the individual organization, thus fostering a creative and festive experience, rich in the culturally diverse representation of San Diego's LGBTQ community.

Pride is proud to partner with **Bankers Hill Community Group** at our annual celebration of Pride. This partnership furthers our ongoing goal of fostering pride, equality, and respect in the LGBTQ community. Thank you, **Bankers Hill Community Group** for your continued partnership.

### San Diego Pride will provide the following:

- 1) Equipment for Festival Area clean-up:
  - a) 50 Trash bins
  - b) 50 Recycle bins
  - c) 2 boxes of trash bin liners
- 2) Coordination of pickup of trash bins and liners on **Wednesday, July 15th** between **1:00pm-4:00pm** at the festival site. Pride's Community Partnerships Manager and Festival Co-Managers will coordinate pickup with BHCG.
- 3) Pick up of 6th Ave bins by Pride volunteers on Monday morning, coordinated with Festival Co-Managers.
- 4) Festival Co-Managers or their designated volunteer department leads will communicate directly with BHCG contact (Ben Baltic 760-889-2271 and Sharou Benedict 760-460-4600) to coordinate trash dropoff locations and times throughout the weekend, from **Saturday, July 18-Monday, July 20**.

- 5) Festival access for volunteers via the Community Partners check-in booth at Pride Village.
- 6) Upon submittal of proper documentation, San Diego Pride shall pay Bankers Hill Community Group no later than **August 31, 2020**:
  - a) \$10 per volunteer per hour (not to exceed \$1,500) for the community clean up in the Pride Festival Area throughout the 2020 Pride Festival weekend.

### Bankers Hill Community Group is responsible for the following:

- 1) Recruit, organize, and coordinate volunteers to clean the Bankers Hill neighborhood, including distribution and maintenance of trash and recycle bins, during the 2020 Pride Parade and Festival.
  - a) Cleanup area to include: Upas St (north) to 1st Ave (west) to Hawthorne St (south) to 6th Ave (east). Exact locations of bins to be determined by BHCG, but should especially concentrate on the area between Laurel St & Ivy St.
- 2) Submit volunteer sign-in sheet with a complete number of hours provided no later than **July 31, 2020**.
- 3) Advertise and promote the Partnership in press releases, flyers, ads, newsletters, social networks, website, etc.
- 4) Send a complete list of volunteers for festival access to the Community Partnerships Managers no



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later than **July 10, 2020**.


